

CARIBBEAN ON THE MOVE

As previously reported CARIBBEAN has had one of its most successful years. This has been evident with CARIBBEAN's larger displays at this years round of boat shows, including Melbourne, Sydney and Mandurah.

New model releases including the C35MKIII and the C49 backed by quality interior refinements to the range of CARIBBEAN boats has seen a surge in sales and new boat orders. This is in complete contrast to the slowing of activity we have experienced over the last couple of years.

Trucks are once again lining up to load newly finished CARIBBEAN's and deliver them to their new owners. The attached photo shows a convoy of three trucks, just loaded and about to head off to WA to deliver a C27 Flybridge Sport Fisherman, a C35 MKIII Flybridge Cruiser and our largest new C49 Flybridge Cruiser.

The new C35 MKIII has enjoyed fantastic sales since its official release in June at the Melbourne Boat Show, the production line has been running non stop since then, with forward orders for both the Australian and export markets well into 2011.

The recent Mandurah boat show displayed a much stronger degree of interest with several new orders already received, this provides further encouragement for continued strong production.
